ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

1. **Entry fee is \$100 per team** for Middle School divisions and includes an Official Sunshine State Games t-shirt for athletes and one coach. NO refunds.
2. **Entry fee is \$150 per team** for High School divisions and includes an official Sunshine State Games t-shirt for athletes and one coach. NO refunds.
3. **Entry fee is \$200 per team** for Open divisions and includes an official Sunshine State Games t-shirt for athletes and one coach. NO refunds.
4. Each team must submit a Team Entry Form **received by April 19, 2013** or register online at **www.flasports.com** by **April 21, 2013**. Rosters and waivers are not to be submitted at this time.
5. An official team roster is available below. Teams must submit an official team roster and a Waiver of Liability for each player at the mandatory coaches meeting.
6. It is the responsibility of the applicant to confirm their registration by visiting **www.flasports.com** or calling toll-free 866-FL-GAMES (866-354-2637).
7. All players must be Florida residents who have lived in the state for at least 30 days prior to the date of competition.
8. Out-of-state college students who attend a Florida school are eligible to compete with a valid college ID.
9. It is the responsibility of the contestant to provide proper proof of residency upon request. A valid Florida state or college ID will serve as proof of residency.
10. All players must be CIPP registered for 2013.

FORMAT

1. The number of teams in each division will determine the format of pool play.
2. The State Director reserves the right to change tournament format based upon participation or inclement weather.
3. All pool play matches will consist of two, seven-minute halves with one-minute halftimes.
4. All championship matches will consist of two, ten-minute halves with three-minute halftimes.
5. A team trophy and Gold medals will be awarded to the champions in each division.
6. Silver and Bronze medals will be awarded to the second and third place teams.

AWARDS

1. A team trophy and Gold medals will be awarded to the champions in each High School and Adult divisions. Silver and Bronze medals will be awarded to the second and third place finishers in each High School and Adult divisions.

RULES

1. The tournament will be conducted in accordance with IRB and USARFU laws including limited substitutions and sin-binning.
2. All decisions of the Division Director or State Director are final.
3. High School division is open to players that were students in a Florida high school for the 2012 – 2013 school year.
4. Open divisions are open to players age 19 and over.
5. Rosters are limited to twelve players and one coach. The coach is not allowed to play unless their team cannot field 7 players.
6. Any roster disputes will be settled by the division director.
7. NO alcoholic beverages are permitted. Any alcoholic beverage brought onto the facility will be confiscated and teams may be ejected from the tournament.
